## **GAMBLING ESTABLISHMENTS**

## **PORTO SANTO: MARITIME CONNECTIONS**

Until 12th April: Passengers boarding at the Funchal Port with Porto Santo Island as destination, should present the PCR screening test for SARS-CoV-2 infection, with a negative result, carried out within a maximum period of 72 hours prior to departure.

### EXCEPTIONS:

- a) Children up to eleven years of age;
- b) Travellers who are residents of Porto Santo Island and are returning to the island within seven days, as they will perform the PCR test on the 5th day after arrival, thus guaranteeing their prophylactic isolation until then;
- c) Travellers who present a medical document, issued in the last 90 days, certifying that they have recovered from COVID-19 disease, or a document certifying that they have been vaccinated against COVID-19.

### PORTO SANTO: MARITIME CONNECTIONS

Travellers should schedule the PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 infection at the Emergency and Public Health Services, at least 4 days (96 hours) in advance, using the following email:

**Performing the PCR screening test for SARS-CoV-2 infection does not incur any charges for the traveller.**
